### Curriculum Document

#### Affiliation

JPHS is a co-education school, affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi (CBSE) and offers education from class I to XII. It prepares students for the All India Secondary and Senior School Certificate Examinations, for the purpose of nurturing socially responsible, global citizens with essential life skills, for which the school boasts of an excellent team of well-qualified and trained staff. Our curriculum is in line with the NEP-2020 in letter and spirit for Grade I to XII. The medium of instruction is English. The student needs a minimum of 75% of attendance out of the total number of working days as on 31<sup>st</sup> January as per the CBSE Guidelines.

#### **Curriculum –**

**Classes I to V** - The text books chosen for Primary classes are based on the prescribed syllabi of CBSE as per the National Curriculum Framework.

**VI to VIII** – At the Middle level the NCERT syllabus is followed as per the CBSE affiliated Schools' Scheme to ensure uniformity in assessment structure and examination pattern. The textbooks are selected as per the prescribed syllabi of CBSE as per NCF.

**IX to XII** - The school follows core curriculum provided by CBSE which is based on National Curriculum Framework-2005 and seeks to provide opportunities for students to achieve excellence in learning through holistic and constructivist development of students through hand-on experiences.

**IX and X** - In class IX the student may choose between Hindi, Sanskrit or French as the Second Language other than the compulsory subjects. There is also a choice offered between Basic Maths and Standard Maths.

Art Education, Health & Physical Education, Work Experience are for Internal Assessment as per the CBSE Scheme of Studies.

**XI and XII** – The school offers three streams in **class XI and XII**. In addition to compulsory Core English, a student has to opt for four other subjects:

**1. Humanities-** Political Science, Commercial Art, Informatics Practices, Psychology, Geography, Math core, Economics, Sociology, Music, History Physical Education, Dance Kathak, Entrepreneurship, Applied Math, French, Marketing

**2. Commerce-** Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Informatics Practices, Commercial Art, Physical Education, Psychology, Entrepreneurship, Math Core, Applied Math, French, Marketing, Music, Dance

**3. Science-** Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics, Informatics Practice, Commercial Art, Physical Education, Psychology, Entrepreneurship, Economics, French, Marketing, Music, Dance

\*Different subject combinations across each stream are offered depending upon the number of students in a batch opting for the subject.

\* Work Experience, Health and Physical Education, General Studies are compulsory for all the streams and will be a part of Internal Assessment. It is compulsory to pass in all of them.
